Department Update:

Public Works – Jason Stordahl

Spring Cleanup & Hazardous Waste Drop Off: Spring Cleanup is underway, with Hazardous Waste Drop Off & Electronic Drop Off this Saturday from 9am-3pm at our Public Works Building. So far the amount of materials placed curb side is very similar to last year. We are running a little behind because of staff shortages, but we hope to get all caught up before the weekend.

Green Site Gate: The gate at our Green Site is now repaired and operational.

Mowing: Two of our summer seasonal labors started work this week, mowing and helping with Spring Cleanup duties.

Wastewater Interconnect Project: Zavoral's have resumed work on the equalization basin. In the upcoming couple of weeks they will be working on grading the EQ basin pond bottom, grading and shaping the existing dike walls of the EQ basin, and working on site work around the new lift station.

Streets: Since the inspection of last year's seal coated areas is complete, we are making it a priority to get those streets swept up as soon as possible. Progress on the sweeping of those streets is going to be delayed somewhat because of Spring Cleanup activities.
