## **Department Update:**

### **Public Works – Jason Stordahl**

**Mosquitoes:** We did not spray for mosquitoes last week, because we were not seeing many of the West Nile breeding mosquitoes.

**Wastewater Pond Decommissioning:** Decommission operations are still moving forward without any major issues.

### **Street Projects:**

#### **Federal Project:**

- **Hwy 220 Multiuse Trail**-work began this past Tuesday.
- **Bygland Rd. Safety Improvements**-Flashing warning signs were installed last Friday. All the improvement work is complete and operational.
- **17<sup>th</sup> ST NW, ADA improvements**-OPP is working on installation of ADA ramps, and hopes to finish the ramps located on the south side of 17<sup>th</sup> by the end of this week. Once complete they will move to the north side.
- **Rhinehart Rd. Paving**- paving is complete
- **1<sup>st</sup> Street SE Overlay**- paving is complete

**Stormwater:** The Army Corps of Engineers completed there our Annual Flood Control System inspection. We will not see their report for a few months, although we did have a discussion after they completed the inspection and it sounds like we are in pretty good shape.
