Wireless Policy

Wireless Internet access is provided free of charge by the East Grand Forks Campbell library for patrons who have the required hardware and software needed for this service. Wireless Internet access users must agree to the following conditions:

1. The laptop patron is responsible for setting up his or her equipment to access the wireless network. The Library accepts no responsibility regarding the ability of patron-owned equipment to connect to the wireless network. Library staff is not permitted to handle a patron's laptop or peripheral equipment. Library staff will not change settings on patron equipment.
2. The Library's wireless connection is unencrypted and unfiltered. Use of the wireless connection is done at the patron's own risk. By using this connection, patrons acknowledge security errors and hacking are an inherent risk associated with any wireless service. For that reason, patrons expressly agree they knowingly assume such risk and further agree to hold the Library harmless from any claim or loss arising out of, or related to, any such instance of hacking or other unauthorized use or access into the patron's computer.
3. The Library accepts no responsibility for any software downloaded and/or installed, email opened, or sites accessed while patrons are on the wireless Internet connection. Any damage done to the patron's equipment, software, data files or self from viruses, identity theft, spyware, plug-ins, or other Internet-borne programs is the sole responsibility of the patron; and the patron indemnifies and holds harmless the Library from any such damage.
4. By choosing to use this free wireless service, a patron agrees to abide by the Library's Internet Usage Policy prohibiting abusive or illegal activity while using the Library's Internet service. This policy can be found at the Circulation desk and at each public access computer station. It is the responsibility of the Patron to understand the Internet Usage Policy and his or her obligation to refrain from viewing inappropriate websites, spamming or any illegal activities.
5. Printing access is not available via the wireless connection. Work will need to be saved to a USB storage device, to Cloud storage or emailed.
6. The Library has made wireless access as available as possible in our library, but a 'dead' spot may be encountered in the library where a wireless reception may be limited. If you have trouble accessing the Internet or staying online please move to a different location within the library.
