







Q4 Do you support a 1% sales tax increase to pay for EGF Parks and Recreation facilities improvements?



Q5 How often do you currently use East Grand Forks Parks and Recreation facilities?



Q6 With improvements, would you use East Grand Forks Parks and Recreation facilities more often?



Q7 Should East Grand Forks have ice available year-round?



Q8 Should East Grand Forks have ice available beginning in August?



Q9 Should East Grand Forks host more youth sports tournaments?










