ORDINANCE NO. 33, 4th Series

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EAST GRAND FORKS, MINNESOTA, AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 152 ENTITLED "ZONING CODE" BY ADDING SUBPARAGRAPH E TO THE USES BY SPECIAL PERMIT SECTION 152.197 AND BY ADOPTING BY REFERENCE CITY CODE CHAPTER 1 AND SECTION 10.99 WHICH, AMONG OTHER THINGS, CONTAIN PENALTY PROVISIONS.

THE CITY OF EAST GRAND FORKS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 152.197 Special uses currently reads:

152.197 SPECIAL USES.

In addition to other uses specifically identified elsewhere in this subchapter, the following are special uses in a C-1, Downtown Commercial District, and require a special use permit based upon procedures and criteria set forth in and regulated by ' 152.022.

- (A) Essential services - public utility uses, transmission services, buildings and storage.
- (B) Gasoline filling stations.
- (C) Hotel, motel, bed and breakfast hotel.
- (D) Satellite dish and antennas, as regulated by " 152.315 *et seq.*

This ordinance shall add subparagraph E to include as a special use for a Body Art Establishment/Tattoo parlor.

Section 2. That Section 152.197 Entitled SPECIAL USES AS AMENDED SHALL NOW READ:

152.197 SPECIAL USES.

In addition to other uses specifically identified elsewhere in this subchapter, the following are special uses in a C-1, Downtown Commercial District, and require a special use permit based upon procedures and criteria set forth in and regulated by ' 152.022.

- (A) Essential services - public utility uses, transmission services, buildings and storage.
- (B) Gasoline filling stations.
- (C) Hotel, motel, bed and breakfast hotel.
- (D) Satellite dish and antennas, as regulated by " 152.315 *et seq.*

(E) Body Art Establishment/Tattoo parlor.

1. Provide at least 1 separate wash facility for every 3 work stations
2. Provide at least 1 separate wash facility for customer use.

Section 3. City Code Chapter 1 entitled "Definitions and General Provisions Applicable to Entire City Code Including Penalty for Violation" and Section 10.99 entitled "Violation a Misdemeanor" are hereby adopted in their entirety, by reference, as though repeated verbatim herein.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and be given the Number 33, 4th Series.
